The institution being a private self-financing affiliated college has limited scope for having the students pan India. However, to promote diversity among the students and faculty, the institution provides an ecosystem and enabling environment for the co-existence of the people coming from different culture, region, linguistic and other socio economic diversities.

The institution has made efforts to provide an inclusive atmosphere that encourages peace, tolerance and harmony among students and faculty. By virtue of the admission process, students across the all districts of the state and cross sections take admissions based on the merit as per the state council guidelines apart from few from other states. Once a student gets admitted he/she will be provided equally with all the resources for bringing harmony and nurture for the holistic development.

Tolerance and Harmony towards Cultural & Regional factors:

To promote cultural and regional heritage with diversity, different festivals and cultural events are organized on the campus to reflect the integrity and unity. To create awareness among the students about the various cultural and regional importance local tours are arranged giving cross culture interactions. Some of the popular regional festivals are celebrated which are identified based on the demographic distribution of the students and faculties.
